Saludables Juntos - Annual Health Fair

According to the <u>2021 census data</u>, Texas is the state with both the largest number and percentage of uninsured residents in the United States, and a much larger share of Texans who identify as Hispanic are uninsured.

- 34% of Hispanic working-aged Texas adults (ages 19-64) are uninsured more than 3x the rate of non-Hispanic white working-age Texans (11%).
- 16% of Hispanic Texas children are uninsured, compared to 8% of non-Hispanic white children lacking coverage.

Through our Saludables Juntos program, we hosted our Annual Healthcare Fair and Know your rights bilingual workshop which aims to bring information and health related services to our TJ families and the community. Thank you to all the wonderful agencies that joined us and made the health fair a success: Any Baby Can, Mama Sana, Integral Care, BlueCross BlueShield of Texas, Austin Transit Partnership, Project Connect, Partners in Parenting, Manos de Cristo, Lirios Pediatrics, Superior Healthplan, CommUnity Care, Planned Parenthood, Texas WIC, and the Lions Club of Austin who offered eye screenings to kids and adults.

Local Community Health Champion, Esther Diaz, talked about language access rights, which state that people have the right to a free interpreter and free translator to assist them with important processes and documentation in organizations, federal agencies, or institutions that receive federal financial assistance. Thank you, Esther, for sharing this critical information with our TJ community!
