Todos Juntos is a bilingual, 2-Gen Family Learning Center, and since 2009, we've been committed to breaking the cycle of poverty by strengthening immigrant families through education. We work with the children and their parents simultaneously, building them up together to create meaningful opportunities – for both. We collaborate in education with families, partner agencies, and our greater community because, if we want to make a change, there's only one way to do it: all together.

WHAT WE OFFER

KIDS

Our Early Childhood Education (ECE) program offers classes that teach children, ages 18 months to 4 years, the skills they need before entering school. And, on average, children end the year 3.5 months ahead, gaining nine months of vocabulary skills in fewer than six months.

ADULTS

Our Adult English as a Second
Language (ESL) program offers
classes to Travis County residents
without a high school diploma,
18 years of age or older. All classes
are taught by professionally trained
instructors, provided by Austin
Community College, and on average,
91% of students advance to the next
level of ESL on the first try. And best
yet, all classes are free of charge.

FAMILIES

Our Mommy and Me parenting program empowers parents to transform their strengths into tools that will help their children grow.

During each class, parents are engaged in their children's weekly literacy theme, followed by fun and educational family activities.

When families join Todos Juntos, we make sure they feel the love and feel that we're doing this together – as a family.
