In our ongoing effort to offer real-world skills and services, SSP has deepened our partnership with Austin Community College (ACC) to introduce a new and important opportunity - Career Pathways!


Every week, during the spring semester, SSP students develop skills and knowledge to further support workforce readiness. During this class, students learn how to write professional resumes, practice for job interviews and search for higher-paying jobs. Students also learn communication skills, as well as career related skills that will better prepare them for the Austin workforce!

Erin Taylor, our onsite Instructor and Coordinator shares: Recently, our SSP students went on a trip to the Hyatt Regency hotel with a beautiful view of Ladybird Lake. We visited the lobby and talked to an event planner, followed by a visit to their Human Resources office. There, students looked at current available positions to get a sense of what opportunities might exist once they're fully prepared to dive into the Austin workforce. They also learned about the benefits of hotel work, including health insurance, tuition reimbursement, free job training and sometimes free vacations, too.

Our students never fail to amaze us with their incredible work ethic and dedication. Their commitment to this class has been rewarding to see. All participants earned a Food Handler's Certificate which can be used to work in any hotel kitchen or restaurant in Central Texas.
