



Highlights of the 2021-22 School Year

- Returned to in-person classes with health and safety screenings in place
- Acquired mud suits + rainboots for outdoor play/learning
- Grew staff and expanded services to our families in response to demand:
 - Added Programs Director and ECE Director
 - Added two additional ECE teachers
 - Started Saludables Juntos program
- Completed outdoor classroom renovations

- New building/facilities since last in-person year
- Built out Saludables Juntos program + plans for our social worker
- Partnered with Junior League for mural painting and virtual "read alouds"
- Completed vision planning led by volunteer and donor Andy Esparza
- Produced Virtual Power of Language event in February 2022
- 44 partnerships

- 155 adults and children completed the 2021-22 school year
 - Despite the challenges they faced this year with COVID, more than half our students went on to the next ESL level

() 64,905

- 50% of children screened with the Ages and Stages Questionnaire (ASQ) were referred for early childhood intervention (ECI)
 - 517 people were provided basic needs support including:

- Food access
- Family outings at Candlelight Ranch
- English Buddy System to help families strengthen their English language skills outside of class time
- Tankproof swim lessons for children and water safety instruction for parents
- Weekly music classes
- Holiday gifts from St. Chubby
- Health care pláticas
- Annual Health Fair and Know Your Health Care Rights Workshop
- Vaccine clinics, PPE distribution, PSAs and other education about vaccinations

COVID Response

- \$82,190 in direct cash assistance and COVID emergency funds granted to our families. This includes more than \$5,300 in HEB gift cards and food assistance to our families in partnership with El Buen Samaritano and their Hands4Hope program.
- Partnered with Austin Public Health to produce PSA in five languages about COVID vaccines for children and teens
- Recruited and trained current and former TJ students as vaccine ambassadors

Saludables Juntos

Todos Juntos' comprehensive health program was started in the fall of 2021 to support our families. Its three primary focus areas are:

- Mental health (combating stigma and increasing access)
- Access to affordable healthcare
- Basic needs (food insecurity, housing insecurity, access to dignified technology)

ACHIEVEMENTS

- Recruited five Vaccine Ambassadors—Todos Juntos parents—who reached out to the Spanish-speaking community to educate them about the importance of COVID vaccines and resources available for vaccinations
- Provided evening mental health workshops in partnership with YWCA
- On-site mammograms provided by The Big Pink Bus and Lone Star Circle of Care
- Had our first dedicated case worker and intern from UT School of Social Work implement and facilitate the Saludables Juntos program

THE NEED:



In Latino families with low income, only **36%** of children are considered ready for kindergarten.



Latinos benefit the most from at least **80 days** of Pre-K the year before starting school.



40% of Central Texas Latinos feel limited by their lack of English skills in their ability to get a job.

64% of the ECE students that were evaluated increased their English vocabulary in just four months.

THE NEED:

Starting from birth, children develop brain connections through their everyday experiences. They're built through positive interactions with their parents and caregivers and by using their senses to interact with the world. A young child's daily experiences determine which brain connections develop and which will last for a lifetime. The amount and quality of care, stimulation and interaction they receive in their early years makes all the difference.

A child's relationships with the adults in their life are the most important influences on their brain development. Loving relationships with responsive, dependable adults are essential to a child's healthy development.

100% of parents reported that they have an improved relationship with their child.




91% of parents reported that they agree or strongly agree that "Learning at home is just as important as learning at school."
