The start of a new school year is right around the corner and we're filled with excitement as our graduated little learners prepare to embark on their next chapter in PreK-3, PreK-4, and kindergarten. Thanks to your generous support we've been able to provide La Escuelita, with essential resources our children need to thrive, at no cost to families. Our dedicated ECE team has worked tirelessly to create a nurturing environment where children learn to cooperate and empathize, build problem-solving abilities, and establish a solid foundation in reading and math. Last year, 98% of La Escuelita students improved in Language, and we're confident that these skills will serve our graduates well as they continue their educational journeys!

Typically, a person without insurance would need to sign up for MAP, visit a primary care doctor, and then request a vision test. Through Saludables Juntos' case management, our social work team is able to provide a **VSP** Eyes of Hope gift certificate for a vision test and new glasses. We're committed to removing barriers and ensuring our students have the tools they need to succeed. During our most recent school year, Saludables Juntos provided 20 VSP gift certificates to TJ families who benefited from this partnership.
