SUPPORTING MINDS, STRENGTHENING FUTURES

At Todos Juntos Learning Center, we believe that learning and growth thrive in an environment of care, safety, and emotional well-being. In Central Texas, less than 30% of Latino individuals who experience mental health challenges receive the support they need — often due to language, access, or cost barriers.

Through our **Saludables Juntos** program, we partner with **St. Edward's University** to provide **free bilingual counseling sessions** for our students. These sessions offer a safe and supportive space where parents and children can talk openly and find the emotional balance they need to thrive. Thanks to this partnership, our community has access to compassionate care helping families navigate life's challenges with strength, hope, and confidence. 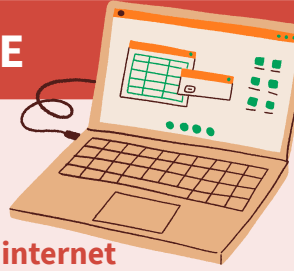

BRIDGING THE DIGITAL DIVIDE



In Central Texas, many families are still navigating the online world for the first time, with **nearly 3 in 10 Texas households with children lacking a computer and high-speed internet** as recently as the COVID era. In addition, a national analysis found that **57% of Latinos ages 16-64 had low or no digital skills, compared with 31% of the U.S. population overall.** That's why access to digital literacy is more essential than ever for learning, working, and staying connected. To help close these gaps, Todos Juntos launched **Computación para Todos**, part of our Adult Education Programs, offering **free computer classes in Spanish.** This semester, 25 participants are learning foundational skills: from using the internet and email to creating and editing documents and spreadsheets. For many, it's the first time in years they've used a computer, and each session brings new moments of growth, pride, and confidence. Beyond technical skills, participants are gaining empowerment and independence, building the confidence to apply for jobs online, adopting telehealth services, support their children's education, and thrive in today's digital world. Through programs like Computación para Todos, we're helping parents and caregivers strengthen their digital skills and create brighter opportunities for their families and community.

MI FAMILIA & ME PUMPKIN PARTY

Our **17th annual Mi Familia & Me Pumpkin Party** was a joyful reminder of what makes the Todos Juntos community so special: families coming together to foster connection and build community.
